



SCHOLARSHIP ANNOUNCEMENT :
**The Vingroup Science & Technology Scholarship Program
for Overseas Study for Master's and Doctoral Degrees -
Academic Years 2024 -2025 and 2025-2026**

I. ABOUT

The Vingroup Science and Technology Scholarship Program for Overseas Study for Master's and Doctoral Degrees (the '**Scholarship Program**') was established by Vingroup with a mission to find talents and provide them with rewarding opportunities so that they can lead and advance the development of science and technology in Vietnam in the future. The Scholarship Program is managed and administered by VinUniversity (<https://vinuni.edu.vn/>).

For 11 years starting from 2019, Vingroup will provide up to 100 full scholarships per year for Master's and Ph.D. degree programs for Vietnamese talents to study key areas at excellent universities in leading countries in terms of science and technology including Australia, Canada, France, German, Israel, Italia, Japan, Russia, Singapore, South Korea, Switzerland, the United Kingdom, and the United States.

Applicants for the Scholarship Program can apply following one of these below tracks:

- **Track 1:** For applicants who have already obtained letters of admission to study a Master's or a Ph.D. program in AY 2024/25 in a supported field or a research area as per Section II of this announcement and at a university among the List of Targeted Universities in Section III below.
- **Track 2:** For applicants who have not been accepted to study a Master's or a Ph.D. program at any of the targeted universities and choose to apply for the scholarship before applying for admission to study in AY 2025/26.

II. SUPPORTED FIELDS OF STUDY

The Scholarship Program gives priority in awarding scholarships to candidates whose intended fields of study or research areas have the potential to create breakthroughs in the development of science and technology in Vietnam. There is also a great demand for high-quality human resources in these fields in Vietnam. III. LIST OF TARGETED UNIVERSITIES

The Scholarship Program identified a list of targeted universities that have excellent graduate programs in the world in the supported fields of study in science and technology. Applicants need to pursue one of the supported fields of study at the targeted universities of the Scholarship Program. IV. SUPPORT FROM THE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

The Vingroup Scholarship Program will provide financial support for students to pursue an approved Master's and Doctoral degree program. The scholarship amount is determined in each case depending on the cost-sharing arrangements between the Scholarship Program and the host institution and the regulations of the Scholarship Program. Typically, students receive a scholarship for 2 years for Master's degree programs and 4-5 years for Doctoral degree programs. To specify, each scholarship grant includes:

- 1. Tuition and fees**
- 2. Monthly stipend/Monthly salary**
- 3. Visa application fee**
- 4. Student health insurance**
- 5. Allowances**
- 6. Other benefits and support when becoming a scholarship recipient**
7. Track 2 applicants will receive reimbursement of application fees to the targeted universities in accordance with the Scholarship Program policy after they are officially awarded the Scholarship.
8. Scholarship recipients will join the network of Vingroup Scholars and will receive support throughout the study program and after graduation in various forms such as receiving information about employment, internship or research collaboration opportunities in Vietnam.

V. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

1. The Scholarships are open to Vietnamese who are living, studying and working in Vietnam or overseas, who have ability, aspiration, creativity, and commitment to contributing to the development of science and technology of Vietnam;
2. **Age:** Not over 30 years old at the start date of the intended Master's program or not over 35 at the start date of the intended Ph.D. program;
3. **Education background:** Have an educational background that matches or relates to the supported fields of study of the Scholarship Program. Be a university graduate with a Bachelor's degree or a college student in the final year of undergraduate study who will graduate before the commencement of the intended Master's or Ph.D. degree program overseas;
4. **Grade Point Average (GPA)** of the undergraduate degree in the related programs must be at least 7.0/10.0 or equivalent;

5. **English Language Proficiency:** Candidates can provide evidence of English language proficiency through the submission of **ONE** of the following proof:

TOEFL	Candidates must have TOEFL iBT score of at least 79. <i>Note: The TOEFL iBT certificate must still be valid at the scholarship application deadline.</i>
IELTS	Candidates must have IELTS score of at least 6.5. <i>Note: The IELTS certificate must still be valid at the scholarship application deadline. Only the IELTS Academic is accepted.</i>
Degree from an English-speaking country	Applicants who are studying or have completed an undergraduate or graduate degree from one of the following English-speaking countries do NOT need to submit the IELTS or TOEFL certificate. The countries include Australia, Canada, New Zealand, Singapore, United States or the United Kingdom (Britain, Ireland, Scotland or Wales).

Note:

- *The Scholarship Program only accepts TOEFL iBT or IELTS Academic certificate.*
 - *Above is the minimum English language proficiency standard of the Scholarship Program. Targeted Universities may have different minimum English requirements that the applicants have to meet in order to satisfy the admission requirements.*
6. **Graduate Record Examination (GRE):** Not required at the time of application. However, please be advised that graduate programs in the United States, Singapore or Israel may require the results of the GRE General Test. Applicants should inquire about the mandatory requirements of their intended universities.
7. **Work experience:** The Scholarship Program does not require applicants to have work experience.

VI. APPLICATION AND REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

The online scholarship application includes:

1. Degree certificates and transcripts: Must be translated and notarized into English if the language of presentation in the original documents is not English;
2. IELTS Academic or TOEFL iBT certificate or an undergraduate and/or a graduate degree from an English-speaking country as specified in Section V of this announcement.
3. Two letters of recommendation/reference from the applicant's professors/lecturers under

whom the applicant has studied or pursued research related to his/her proposed field of study, or from supervisors, who have supervised the applicant's work related to his/her proposed field of study. The letters of recommendation must meet the following criteria:

- Must be written in English; and
 - Must have an official letterhead and the signature of the recommender;
4. A letter of motivation written in English and does not exceed 1,500 words. The essay demonstrates the ability, aspiration, creativity and commitment to contributing to the development of science and technology in Vietnam.
 5. A curriculum vitae (CV) in English that outlines educational background and research experience;

In addition:

Official letter of admission:

Track 1 applicants will need to submit a letter of admission with the program start date in AY 2024/25 issued by one of the Targeted Universities in Section III of this announcement. Please note that applicants who have been admitted with partial financial support from the host institutions will be given priority over the others.

Choices of universities: For Track 2 applicants, the Scholarship Program asks every applicant to select five universities that offer programs that match personal intent and fall within the supported fields of study shown in Section II of this announcement. At the same time, the selected study programs have to be among the top-ranked programs in the world.

VII. SELECTION PROCESS

The Selection process consists of three rounds:

▪ **ROUND 1: Initial Application Screening**

After the scholarship application deadline, the Scholarship Program will conduct an initial eligibility screening to ensure that the applications meet all the minimum, pre-determined requirements. After that, the Scholarship Selection Committee will review the applications and shortlist the most suitable candidates for the interview round.

▪ **ROUND 2: Interview**

The Scholarship Selection Committee will conduct the Interview Round which will be in English and last up to 45 minutes for each interview via teleconference or face-to-face if circumstances permit.

▪ **ROUND 3*: Apply for Admission at Targeted Universities**

After passing the Interview Round, shortlisted candidates who have not had any letter of admission from any Targeted University will apply to at least five (05) proposed universities which are approved by the Selection Committee. Candidates who obtain at least one unconditional admission offer to study a qualified graduate program according to the

Scholarship Program's policies will then be officially recognized as a Vingroup scholarship recipient.

****Note:** Track 1 candidates who have already had admission offers from a supported field of study at a Targeted University do not need to participate in Round 3 after the interview. All applicants will be notified of the final results.*

VIII. SELECTION CRITERIA

The application and selection process of the Vingroup Science & Technology Scholarship Program for Overseas Studies for Master's and Doctoral Degrees is **open, competitive, transparent and free of charge**. Members of the Selection Committee are prominent professors in various fields of science and technology. Applicants do not need to pay any fees to anyone in order to apply for the scholarship.

Scholarship recipients are selected based on Ability, Aspiration, Creativity, and Commitment (AACC) to contributing to the development of science and technology in Vietnam.

IX. SCHOLARSHIP CONDITIONS

Applicants must fully meet the application requirements of the Scholarship Program as well as having a letter of admission from a targeted university listed above to study a supported academic field. Applicants must also meet the health requirements through a General Health Check Program before commencing their studies and be issued a valid visa to study the program overseas. During the study program, applicants must meet the minimum academic requirements determined by the program as well as reporting their academic performance and research progress periodically to the Scholarship Program

Scholarship recipients who have completed their final academic requirements of the Master's and/or doctoral degree are eligible to stay in the Host country to work in their field of study for up to one year for Master's graduates and up to two years for Ph.D. graduates. After that, scholarship recipients must return to Vietnam to work full-time for a Vietnamese public university or research institute or work for a member company/research institute/training facility of the Vingroup ecosystem for at least the duration of time equal to the duration of study that they had received the scholarship to study the master's or doctoral degree. Scholarship recipients who complete a Master's degree on the Scholarship Program support can continue onto the doctoral degree on other sources of funding right after the Master's degree completion. After finishing the doctoral degree, they will come back to work in Vietnam as the program regulations.

X. REINTEGRATION SUPPORT

In order to complete an overall and comprehensive investment process in the science and technology human resources in Vietnam, the Program will support scholarship recipients throughout their study and provide them with regular updates on employment opportunities, internships or research projects in Vietnam. This support scheme ensures that the awarded students can be able to optimize their intellectual capability in an overseas university environment while staying connected with the Vietnamese settings.
